Instructions for Hershey Kiss Rose Bud Bouquet

- 1. Take two Hershey Kisses, and place one flat side onto the other flat side of each Kiss.
- 2. Wrap the two kisses with a piece of the cellophane.
- 3. Insert the pointed side of a skewer into the pointed side of the bottom Hershey Kiss and wrap the excess cellophane around the skewer.
- 4. Take the floral tape and begin to wrap the skewer with the tape beginning as close to the point on the bottom Hershey Kiss as possible. Slightly tug the floral tape to activate the stickiness. While tugging gently, twist the skewer, and continue to wrap the tape all the way down to the bottom of the skewer. Tear off the remaining floral tape.
- 5. Repeat until all six skewers/rose buds are completed.
- 6. Arrange your rose buds into a bouquet. Use the rubber bands to keep the skewers into the shape of a bouquet.
- 7. Place the bouquet onto a corner of the burlap, making sure the back buds of the bouquet fully sit on the burlap.
- 8. Fold the bottom corner of the burlap to partially cover the stems. Fold over one side of the burlap to cover the stems and then fold the same side corner of the burlap back out. Repeat on the other side corner of the burlap. Tie the ribbon around the entire bouquet (you might need a second person to hold the burlap in place while you tie the ribbon into a bow). Happy Valentine's Day!
