# Tea Light Craft - Witches (Elphaba!)



#### Materials:

- 1. Green flameless tea lights.
- 2. Googly eyes
- 3. Craft felt or foam board for hat (included) and buckle (optional)
- 4. Yellow yarn
- 5. Black ribbon (optional—not included)
- 6. Rhinestone for "mole"
- 7. Tweezers (not included)
- 8. Glue gun and glue sticks (not included)

### Instructions:

- 1. Using the template, trace and cut out the witch's hat. Using the piece of yellow yarn, glue on a hat band. With yellow foam board, cut out a buckle, and glue onto the center of the hat band. Glue the hat onto the tea light. Make sure you glue the hat with the light switch positioned on the bottom at the back of the tea light.
- 2. Next, glue the eyes to the base of the candle, positioning them on each side of the "nose."
- 3. Glue on the rhinestone to make a witch's wart.
- 4. With extra ribbon, you can hang the witch(es) on your window for display or use ribbon to hang tea light around your neck as a pendant! Have fun!

## Tea Light Craft - Pumpkins



#### Materials:

- 1. Orange flameless tea lights
- 2. Black rhinestones for mouth
- 3. Googly eyes
- 4. Mini popsicle sticks
- 5. Green pipe cleaners
- 6. Ribbon (optional—not included)
- 7. Tweezers (not included)
- 8. Glue gun and glue sticks (not included)

#### Instructions:

- 1. Position the switch pointing to the bottom, and glue the mini popsicle stick to the back of the orange tea light. Be sure you don't cover up the switch!
- 2. Using a pen or a cylindrical object, make a spiral-looking pumpkin leaf with the pipe cleaner and attach to the popsicle stem.
- 3. Glue on two googly eyes.
- 4. Glue on five-six smaller rhinestones for the mouth.
- 5. Optional: Glue on ribbon on the back to either hang on your window for decoration or to hang around your neck as a pendant! Enjoy!
